

Recommended Tradespeople



Rosemary Williams holds a list of tradespeople who have been recommended by members of the WTu3a so if you are looking for someone to do a job for you it may be worthwhile checking with her first.

Whilst neither the u3a or the recommending member can guarantee or accept responsibility for the work carried out it is useful to gain from other people's experience.

If you email Rosemary with the type of work you wish to be done, she will provide you with details of WTu3a member(s) who have recommended a trades person with those skills. It is then up to you to contact the member and seek their advice.

Obviously, this scheme can only work if members are prepared to spend a few minutes to pass on their recommendations to Rosemary and are prepared to talk to the requesting members about their recommendation.

Here are just some of the trades on the current list, although there may be more. Just ask.
