WHERE	Wellcome Collection
WHAT	<p>The Wellcome Collection is a museum and library that aims to challenge how we all think and feel about health. Through exhibitions, collections, live programming, digital, broadcast and publishing, it creates opportunities for people to think deeply about the connections between science, medicine, life and art. Free entrance to everything.</p> <p>There are two major exhibitions; BEING HUMAN – divided into Genetics, Minds & Bodies, Infection and Environmental Breakdown MEDICINE MAN – a collection of historical items from around the world. Here, you can find out how people have viewed the basics of life over the centuries – birth, health, sex and death.</p> <p>There will be at least one minor exhibition, current theme unknown.</p>
LOCATION	The Wellcome Collection is based at 183 Euston Road, London NW1 2BE – about 300 yards west of Euston Station.
FACILITIES	Lifts to all floors. Toilets on most floors. Shop, café and restaurant.
TIMING	Leave WT 9.30 am by coach – aim to arrive WC by 11am. We have 20 spaces on a short 30 minute tour at 11.30am, for everyone else it will be self-guided – the Collection is set up on this basis. After lunch in the café, restaurant or one nearby continue browsing. Leave 4pm

OTHER ACTIVITIES	The British Library is 0.4 miles east of the Wellcome Collection. There are a number of cafes and restaurants nearby.
