

## TRIPS 2024

### **Hampton Court Palace - Wednesday 17th April**

Cost has yet to be finalised but the entry to the palace is £20.10p if over 65 and the tour and coach will be in the region of £20 each. Anyone who is a Historic Palace Member can get into Hampton Court free on production of their membership card. Tulips are included in the price of admission. There is a really nice large cafe on site or you can take a picnic.
